PARCC

- Paper vs. Pencil
 - Howard is for paper
- Q: How many students have computers at home?
 - A: Not Sure
- Q: Was there a bump with doing paper/ pencil last year?
 - A: We don't know because there were other variables (new curriculum, new teachers, etc.)
- Ask the students what they prefer?

- SLT Responsibilities
 - Should be collaborative
 - Decisions should be made by a consensus
 - Unanimous
 - Majority
- CSC: Board of Directors
 - Bigger Decisions
- SLT: Line Managers
 - More day to day
 - Implementation
- CSC Responsibilities
 - Budget and decide how money is distributed throughout the school
 - Enrollment projections
 - 90% is on staff
 - Not focusing on individuals
 - UIP
 - High level priorities to improve the school
 - Can divvy up the responsibilities
- SLT Responsibilities
 - Some overlap in the UIP
 - Master Schedule (Students and Teachers)
 - No part in the budget
 - Increasing enrollment strategies
 - Implementing instructional practices
 - Plan blue/ green days
- Scenario # 1: Budget needs to be cut \$70,000.
 - CSC needs to collaborate on the budget cut
 - Materials?
 - Faculty?
 - SLT is not involved
- Scenario # 2: SLT is deciding between 20 minute vs 40 minutes music class. If 40 minutes is opted then data teams will not have enough time to meet and plan.
 - This is a SLT decision
 - CSC would not be overly involved
- Scenario #3: SLT and SCS share UIP decisions
 - Differences
 - SLT writes UIP
 - CSC holds the school accountable
 - CSC can get parent involvement while SLT is made up of teachers
